- Any person who has passed the High School Proficiency Exam or the General Educational Developmental (GED) test, OR
- Any person 18 years of age or older who can profit from instruction, OR
- Any K-12 students meeting the criteria listed under "Special Admission of Minor Students." (call for information)

COURSES

The cosmetology program is designed to exceed minimum Board of Cosmetology standards. A combination of lecture and laboratory instruction includes

- personal hygiene and grooming;
- salesmanship and skills in sterilization, and principles of sanitation;
- safety requirements for the operation of a beauty salon;
- principles of chemistry;
- laws and administrative regulations.

Proficiencies to be developed include

- hairstyling, chemical waving and straightening,
- haircutting and shaping, hair coloring, scalp and hair treatments,
- facials, manicuring (including acrylic nails), and operation of a beauty salon.

It takes a minimum of 1600 contact hours to complete the Board of Cosmetology requirements.
